

Remote Learners

Connecting to Verizon Hotspots

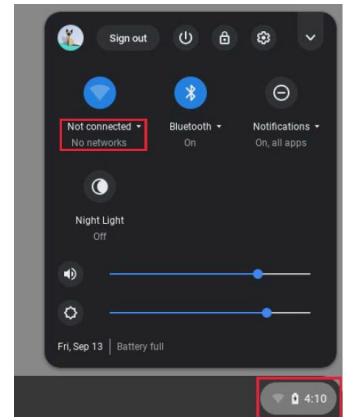
1.) Plug the *hotspot* into the provided power adapter and a home electrical outlet (hotspot should turn *on* automatically upon doing this).

a.) If it did not turn *on* - Hold the **Power Button** for about 3 seconds and release it to turn on the Hotspot.

2.) Count for about 90 seconds for it to fully start (the hotspot may show *data usage* now to let you know it is running).

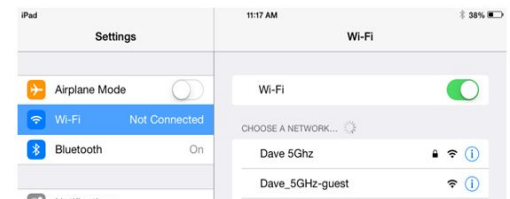
3a.) Chromebook:

- The Chromebook should **Automatically** connect to the **DCS HotSpot Wifi**, if not:
 - A. Open (click/tap) the Chrome OS **Menu** on the bottom right corner near the clock (highlighted in red).
 - B. Click/tap the **Wireless Network** drop down menu (highlighted in red).
 - C. Click/tap the **DCS HotSpot Wifi** name.



3b.) iPad:

- The iPad should **Automatically** connect to the **DCS HotSpot Wifi**, if not:
 - A. Click/tap the **Settings** app.
 - B. Click/tap **Wi-Fi** on the left-hand menu.
 - C. Click/tap the **DCS HotSpot Wifi** name.



3c.) Windows:

- The laptop should **Automatically** connect to the **DCS HotSpot Wifi**, if not:
 - A. Click/tap the **Wifi icon** (either one highlighted in red below) located in the bottom right corner near the clock on the Windows Taskbar.

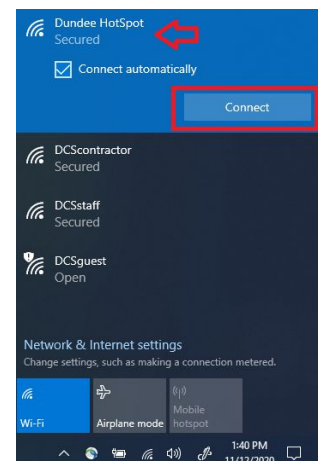


(Not Connected to any Wifi network.)

- B. The available **Wireless Networks** menu will appear; click/tap the **DCS HotSpot wifi** network followed by the **Connect** button (highlighted in red).
